

KBOCC Graduation, Transfer, Student Retention - Students Enrolled Fall 2009 - Summer 2010



The unduplicated student count for students enrolled in the Fall 2009 - Summer 2010 semesters totals 101 students. Of those students 12 were full-time degree-seeking students; 38 were part-time degree seeking students. The remainder of students fall in the categories of enrichment, Ability to Benefit, Advanced Secondary, Audit, or undecided and not yet degree-seeking.

Of the 101 students enrolled in the Fall 2009 - Summer 2010 semesters 84 were Native-American and 17 were Caucasian. Eighteen of the students were male, 83 were female.
